5.2. Special hazards arising from the substance or mixture

The heat from fire increases inner pressure in containers and can cause their bursting or explosion. The exploding containers could fly up to the distance several ten meters. In the event of fire, carbon monoxide, carbon dioxide and other toxic gases may arise. Inhalation of hazardous degradation (pyrolysis) products may cause serious health damage.

5.3. Advice for firefighters

Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) with a chemical protection suit only where personal (close) contact is likely. Use a self-contained breathing apparatus and full-body protective clothing.
